

Lab: Simple joins

Make a serious effort to answer all questions from memory before referring to lecture slides or other resources.

1. Read the 'courses-ddl.sql' and 'courses-small.sql' files into SQLite. (Files available on iLearn.)
2. Write SQL to answer the following questions:
 - a. For every course taken by a student, show the student's ID, name, and course taken. (Hint, use tables 'student' and 'takes'.)
 - b. Show the names of all students who have taken course "CS-190", as well as the year in which they took the course.
 - c. For every course taught by an instructor, show the instructor's name and the course that is taught.
 - d. Do the same as in the previous question, but do not show duplicates.
 - e. Do the same as in the previous question, but sort by instructor name.
 - f. Give the names of the buildings in which the student with name "Williams" has taken a class.
